

## **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

- Larger size TacDecals will require 2 people to install. Care should be taken when installing your TacDecal to keep it from rolling and sticking to itself. This can be very hard to separate without damaging the printed area of the decal.
- 2. Locate the area you would like to display your new TacDeal.
  - a. TacDecals are designed for interior use only, so be sure the location is a climate controlled environment.
  - **b.** Measure the area to make sure it is large enough for your TacDecal.
  - c. Make sure the surface is smooth and clean. Even if you think the surface doesn't need to be cleaned, clean it. Use a warm lightly dampened cloth and allow the wall to dry thoroughly. Do not use soap or cleaning supplies.
  - d. Textured walls are **not recommended**. Newly painted walls should be allowed to dry for 1 month prior to the installation of your new TacDecal.

- 3. Remove your TacDecal from the box and unroll it. Allow enough time for the TacDecal to flatten before trying to remove it from the backing. When removing it from the backing be careful not to let it roll over and stick to itself. It can be very hard to separate without damaging the printed area of the decal.
- 4. Grab the corners and place one end on the wall. Slowly applying the TacDecal to the wall by sliding your hand toward the other corner using a minimum of pressure.
- 5. Now work from the center toward the edges pushing out any air bubbles as you work your way to the outside edges of your TacDecal.
- 6. If your TacDecal comes in 2 pieces, install the bottom piece first. Then very carefully align the top half with the bottom and work your way toward the top of the TacDecal. Use the same technique described in step 5 to remove any air bubbles.

Enjoy your new TacDecal and show it off to all your friends.



## PROPER SURFACES FOR TACDECALS

- 1. Smooth, non-textured, matte or gloss painted drywall.
- 2. Smooth glass or metal surfaces.
- 3. Smooth wall paper, or wood

## **IMPROPER SURFACES FOR TACDECALS**

- 1. Textured walls or wallpaper.
- **2.** Brick or cinder block.
- 3. Any surface that is rough, or porous
- 4. Unpainted drywall.
- 5. Outdoor wall surfaces of any kind.
- 6. Vehicles.
